


Horizon 2020

- Largest EU Research and Innovation programme ever.
- €80 billion funding available from 2014 to 2020.
- All types of activities, from frontier science to close-tomarket innovation.
- **Mexico** not automatically eligible for funding under the Horizon 2020 budget but can be a partner.
- 59 participations from Mexico (among which 24 MSCA)

## Mexico and Horizon 2020

- Participation:
- be an individual or organisation/institution under the national law of Mexico
- have the financial capacity to carry out the research tasks set out in your proposal.
- Some calls require a consortium to include participants based in specific non-EU countries in order to be eligible

# Steps for being involved in a H2020 research project

1. Search the H2020 Participant Portal for a suitable call for proposals.

- carefully study the call description, terms of reference and all related documents.
- make use of the H2020 Online Manual
- 2. Find project partners
- 3. Create an individual account on the Participant Portal.
- 4. Register your organisation.
- 5. Submit your project proposal to the European Commission.



### H2020:Tools for researchers from **Mexico** to find European research partners

- 1. H2020 <u>Participant Portal</u>, which includes a <u>Partner Finding Tool</u>.
  - Individual researchers: Create a personal profile on the Participant Portal.
  - Institutions: <u>create a unique organisation</u> profile to receive a 9-digit number (PIC).
- 2. <u>Projects & Results Service CORDIS</u> :database of institutions and/or research consortia that have successfully participated in previous projects funded by Horizon 2020
- 3. EURAXESS website: partner finding tool.



### Become an independent expert for the EC

- Researchers can join the database of independent experts.
- The European Commission appoints independent experts to assist with: evaluation of proposals, monitoring of projects, evaluation of programmes, and the design of policy.
- > open to any researcher with a high level of expertise in his or her relevant fields
- Financial compensation, sometimes a visit to Brussels.



#### Tips & Tricks for writing a good Individual Fellowship proposal

General

#### Closely follow the call requirements:


Be in line with the actions' objectives and rationale. Know the differences between Global & European Fellowships.

Follow the guideline's instructions: Use the structure provided in the template and address all the evaluation criteria.

#### You are not writing an academic article:

Be personal and flag your achievements and skills as if you were applying for a job. You are!

Start early and submit the right draft on time



#### Credibility, clarity and feasibility are key: In all sections of your proposal.

Get a second opinion: Have your proposal proof-read and pre-screened.

# Excellence

#### Connecting all the parts:

Make sure the description of your project is in line with your objectives

#### Description of your methods and objectives:

Be as precise and clear as you can be, avoid omissions, fuzzy claims, vagueness or generalization.

#### Innovate:

Emphasise innovative aspects - get beyond the state of the art.

#### Broaden the scope of your research:

Connect to other disciplines or the non-academic sector. It may get you extra points.

Net4M@bility

#### Impact – Be Unique:

Specify the impact of your research and how it can be measured.

Impact

#### Highlight the EU-Dimension:

Show that your proposal addresses EU policy or societal challenges being faced in the EU and beyond. Show that your work is timely and relevant.

#### It's about taking you further:

Show how the project will further your professional carrier and how the foreseen training will complement your research and professional profile.

#### Spread the news:

Wide dissemination is required. Describe the target groups of your results: academic circles, general public, etc.

# Implementation

#### Pay attention to your Gantt Chart:

Project deliverables and milestones should be clearly presented.

#### Knowledge transfer is crucial:

Outline the complementarity, commitment and mutual benefits to all parties involved, at all levels – researcher, host, national etc.

#### Outline the hosts' strong points:

A good record relevant to your research, special facilities and significant collaborations make for an environment that's conducive to your research.

#### Be bold - Assess risks:

Increase the credibility of your proposal by defining measures to monitor your projects progress and suggest coherent plans to mitigate risk.



- Career Restart Panel (CAR),
- support experienced researchers wishing to resume research in a Member State or Associated Country after a career break
- (e.g. after parental leave, working outside research, etc.).
- The applicants must not have been active in research for at least 12 consecutive months within a time period of 18 months immediately prior to the call deadline.



### **MSCA COFUND**

WHAT? support the funders Max 5 years. Minimum 3 months mobility

WHO? European institutions that fund or manage doctoral programmes or fellowship programmes for researchers. Organisations from LAC can be partner organisations in a proposal.

### Annual calls

Researchers from Mexico can apply to the fellowships published on EURAXESS Job portal

ESEARCHERS IN MOTION

MSCA CoFund: Partner Organisations from Mexico

- May recruite, supervise, host or train the researchers from any sector, any country
- Reimbursed by the beneficiary (can't claim costs directly from REA) as they don't signed the Grant Agreement
- Partner organisations must include a Letter of Commitment in Part B of the proposal to state their role in the action and commitments if they contribute to the programme funding

- Partner organisation: Non-signatory to the Grant Agreement;
- contributes by providing training and hosting researchers during secondments, but does not employ researchers under the project.
- Partner organisations must include a Letter of Commitment in Part B of the proposal (except for Partner Organisations in IF-EF)



### MSCA – ITN for Mexican institutions

- All organisations can join as a partner organisation without having to secure their own funding.
- The following costs will be reimbursed by the consortium:
- Participation in the supervisory board and other relevant meetings
- hosting secondments or being involved in a training
- Partner Organisations complement the training programme or host secondments but **do not recruit** any researchers


